

Interactive Whiteboards	Web 2.0
Comprises of a touch sensitive board, data projector hooked up to a computer or laptop. The IWB is operated by pen, finger or via a tablet or wireless keyboard. Content and concepts can be displayed and interacted with by the user. Surfacing in UK classrooms around the start of the century, they are a relatively recent addition to Australian classrooms and many schools are still investigating their potential for educational purposes.	A term used to describe a new wave of web based applications and services that allow for read/write capabilities. Web 1.0 mean consume where websites were static and could only be altered by experts with web authoring skills; while Web 2.0 stands for create where anyone with access can become their own personal publisher. Web 2.0 services are generally characterized as free and easy to integrate and manipulate in different ways using the technology of RSS, which separates content from form.

You get new possibilities for connecting to others, utilizing new online applications and accessing new resources that open up new possibilities for learning with your students.
